Introduction

Government Polytechnic, Pune is one of the six lead Polytechnics in the Department of Technical Education, Government of Maharashtra. This institute is situated in a belt of diversified industries and reputed academic institutes. Academic Autonomy is conferred to the institute in 1994 by the Government of Maharashtra.

Location

The Institute is located in the scenic campus on the backdrop of Chaturshrungi hills on Savitribai Phule Pune University Road. The institute is well connected by road, railway and air. The distances from Shivajinagar bus station, Pune Junction Railway Station and Pune international airport being 3 km, 7 km and 21 km respectively.

The main building of the Institute is accorded with the status of Heritage Building by the Pune Municipal Corporation. The institute Campus is spread over 11.5 hectares (26.8 acres). The departments of Civil, Electrical, Mechanical, Metallurgy, Applied Mechanics, Administrative office are functioning in Main building. 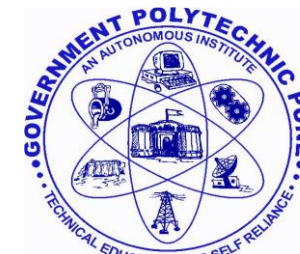

Target Group

Registration

- The course is open for faculty from AICTE and DTE approved polytechnics in the state of Maharashtra. Maximum of two participants are allowed from one institute. Accommodation will be provided at Trainee Hostel within the campus on paid basis.
- Faculty with at-least Five years of teaching experience and involved in NBA process (preferably senior faculty) should apply. Selection of trainee rests with the discretion of the selection committee. Selected trainee should accompany with permission letters from their authority.
- The selected trainee are eligible for travel expenses at the rate of III AC rail fare along the shortest route for to and fro journey. It is essential to produce evidence for such travel.
- Interested faculty should submit scanned copy of Registrations form duly signed by Head of Institution. They should mail this registration form on tpo@gppune.ac.in on or before last date of registration. Late registration shall not be accepted.
- Selected trainees will be informed via email only. They should submit hard copy of Registration Form mailed to the registration authority along with a cheque in favour of "Principal, Govt. Polytechnic, Pune" for Rs 1000/- against security deposit by hand delivery/speed post/ courier on the address for communication mentioned in this information leaflet only.
- Only 25 participants will be selected for the course and late applications will not be entertained.
- Attendance for all sessions of the training program is compulsory. Security deposit cheque will be returned back only after successfully completion of the training.
