## Schedule:

9th October, 2024: The preparation for the event began on 9th October when a group of six students assembled five containers made from premade cardboard boxes. The students then decorated the boxes to make them easily identifiable. After the boxes were ready, the team
Placed them at the designated collection locations. Additionally, posters promoting the

e-waste drive were created and placed on notice boards in various departments to raise awareness. A volunteer team for the program was formed on this day.
